

MODERN PRESS FTP INSTRUCTIONS

- Zip or Stuff your files for faster transfers and to keep them from being corrupted.
- Download an evaluation copy of WinZip 8.0 at: <http://www.winzip.com/ddchomea.htm>
Mac users can download an evaluation copy of Stuffit Deluxe at <http://www.stuffit.com>
- Send an e-mail to desktop@superprinter.com anytime you post something to the ftp site.

There are three ways that you can connect to the FTP site. One is with ftp software, another is with your Internet browser and the third is by creating a shortcut in "My Network Places" (if you are running Windows ME, XP or 2000).

1. FTP SOFTWARE

If you are using ftp software to connect to the site, the following information is needed in order to setup a site profile and connect using your FTP software.

Host Name: <code>ftp://209.98.251.137</code>	Passive Mode:	No
User ID: As supplied*	Host Type:	Automatic Detect
Password: As supplied*	Startup Transfer Mode:	Automatic Detect

2. INTERNET BROWSER

To use your Internet browser, type in the following URL information: `ftp://209.98.251.137`

You will be prompted to enter your user name and password. Once connected, drag and drop your files onto the site. If you are using Internet Explorer, click on Tools (at the top of the browser window), then Internet Options and then select the Advanced tab. Look for an option (if available) that enables browsing of ftp sites (ENABLE FOLDER VIEW FOR FTP SITES) and make sure this option is checked. Most brands and versions have this option set by default. Please review your browser's help file under FTP for additional information.

3. MY NETWORK PLACES (if you are running Windows ME, XP or 2000)

1. Open Windows Explorer
2. Click on "My Network Places" (There may also be a shortcut to My Network Places on your desktop.)
3. Click on "Add Network Place"
4. Type in `ftp://USER NAME:PASSWORD@209.98.251.137` into the field provided and follow the instructions on the screen.

This will allow you to connect using Windows Explorer and you will be able to copy and paste or drag and drop the files between the FTP site and your computer. Please review the help file available in My Network Places for additional information.
